Player and Parent Code of Conduct (2026-27)

At CVHAA, we seek athletes and families who are committed to Christ and strive to live by biblical principles both on and off the field. Participation in our sports programs is a privilege, not a right. Players and parents are expected to demonstrate integrity, humility, and sportsmanship in a way that honors the Lord, builds community, and sets a Christlike example for others.

Player Code of Conduct: As a CVHAA athlete, I agree to:

- Represent Christ, my family, and my team with integrity and respect at all times.
- Treat teammates, coaches, opponents, officials, and spectators with honor and kindness.
- Refrain from lying, cheating, stealing, or any form of dishonest or disrespectful behavior.
- Avoid the use of profanity, obscene gestures, or inappropriate language.
- Abstain from alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, and performance-enhancing substances at all times, including at all team events.
- Demonstrate sportsmanship in both victory and defeat.
- Respect the authority and instruction of my coaches.
- Be on time and prepared for practices, games, and team events, communicating in advance if I must be absent.
- Take responsibility for my attitude, effort, and improvement.
- Respect all facilities, equipment, and property entrusted to our team.
- Not argue with umpires or officials and allow my coaches to address any concerns.

Parent Code of Conduct: As a CVHAA parent or guardian, I agree to:

- Support the mission of CVHAA to build Christlike character through competitive athletics.
- Encourage my player to honor Christ in both words and actions.
- Refrain from coaching my player or other players during games and practices.
- Speak respectfully to and about coaches, officials, players, and other parents at all times.
- Allow coaches to make decisions regarding playing time, positions, batting order, and in-game strategy without interference.
- Address any concerns directly and respectfully with the head coach at an appropriate time.
